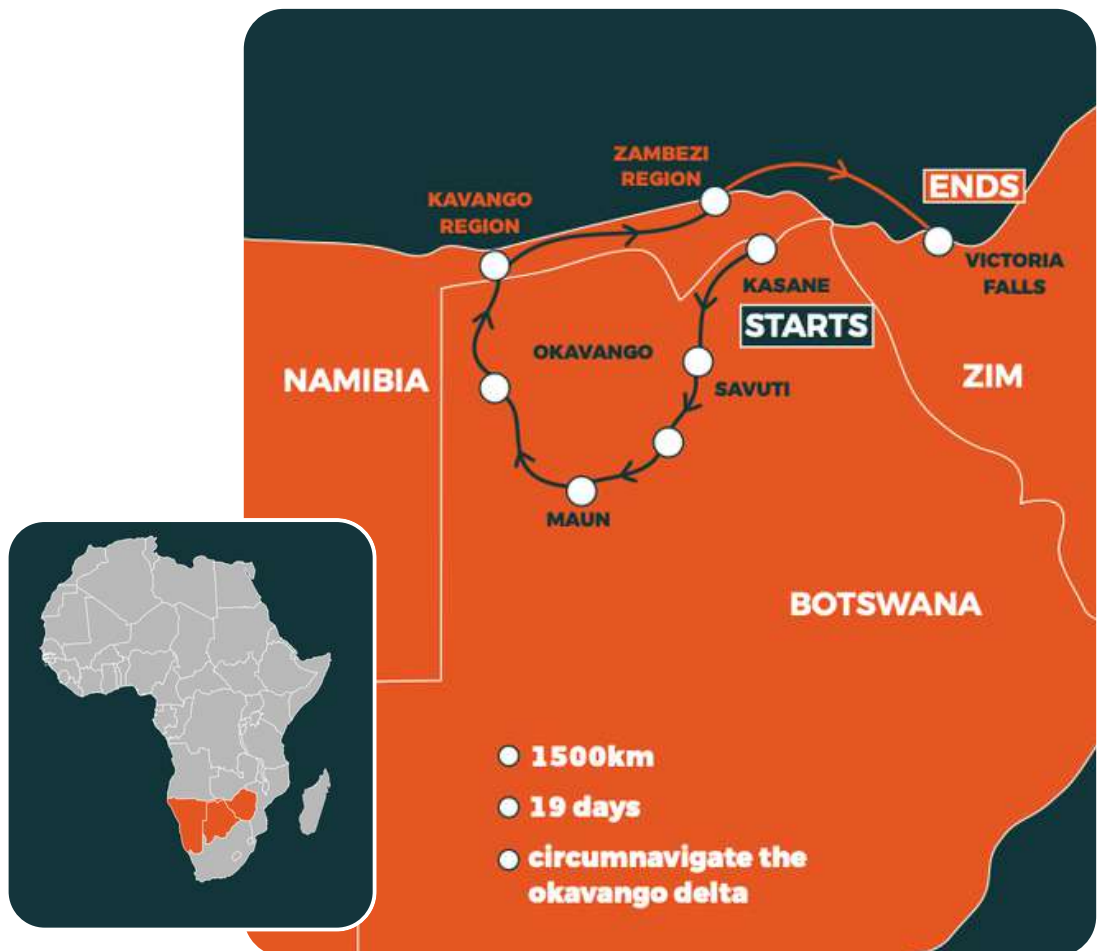

The Journey

Starting on the Chobe River in Kasane and finishing at Victoria Falls, the route circumnavigates the Okavango Delta - traversing remote regions where water defines both landscape and wildlife.



Highlights

Highlights include the game-rich Chobe Riverfront, the wild regions of Savuti and Khwai to the gateway town of Maun. The western side of the delta all the way into the Caprivi Strip of Namibia. The Kavango, the Kwando and the Zambezi rivers all visited from within Namibia and finally concluding at Victoria Falls.



Accommodation

A well-considered blend of camping and comfortable lodges allows for a deeper connection to Botswana's wilderness. With all logistics handled, you can focus on the experience—unhurried travel, meaningful wildlife encounters, and the shared rhythm of life on the road.

Vehicles & Travel

Drive yourselves on this guided overland journey

The vehicles for your journey are automatic Toyota Hilux Double Cab 4x4s – reliable, comfortable, and built for African adventures.

Each vehicle seats four adults with ease and comes fully equipped for camping, featuring two side-by-side rooftop tents (complete with bedding and towels), a practical camp kitchen with gas cooker, a 40L fridge, table and chairs, and a built-in water tank. Recovery gear is also supplied with every vehicle, ensuring peace of mind on remote routes.

Travelling in convoy, the group is led by your guide in a similarly equipped Hilux. The guide vehicle is fitted with radio communication, a satellite phone, first aid kit, and additional recovery equipment – providing safety, support, and expert knowledge throughout the journey.

All you need to do is pack your bag, bring your adventurous spirit, and hop on a plane to Africa – everything else is taken care of.



Accommodation & Catering

Prepare your own gourmet meals in the bush

This journey offers a thrilling blend of camping and lodge stays, giving you the best of both worlds. Most nights are spent at carefully chosen campsites, selected for their stunning locations, character, or sense of wilderness.

Several nights are spent in comfortable lodges or hotels, providing the perfect opportunity to relax and recharge in style.

Your fully equipped 4x4s set you up for an authentic self-catering adventure, with everything needed for meals over the coals or on gas. While most meals are prepared in camp, select meals are provided, and some destinations offer excellent local restaurants to sample regional flavours.

The route has been thoughtfully planned with convenient restocking points, and clear guidance on shopping and managing supplies ensures you're fully prepared while enjoying the freedom and excitement of exploring Namibia at your own pace.
